

An Invitation to Adventure School's Mihi Whakatau for New Students and their Whānau Nau mai, haere mai

Dear families,

Adventure School warmly invites you and your whānau to our mihi whakatau on **Wednesday 24 February**. It is an opportunity for the whole school to formally welcome you and your child(ren). Due to CoVid 19 we have been unable to hold a welcome since February of 2020 and a lot of pupils have joined our ever-growing kura since then!

An Outline of the Process:

- Children go to class as usual
- 8:45am Briefing for adults under the shade cloth in Kōwhai Syndicate's courtyard.
- 9:00am New students rejoin adults under the shade cloth
- 9:10am approx- Staff and senior students will lead the karanga and the haka 'Te Waka' as new families walk down the centre aisle of the hall.
- New students and whanau will sit on mats at the front of the hall.
- Principal, John Wootton, will speak, formally welcoming you to Adventure School, followed by the school waiata, 'You Can Count on Me'.
- Someone will speak on behalf of new families (if you would like to do this please email Carl McManaway <u>cmcmanaway@adventure.school.nz</u>). New families will echo the waiata 'E Toru Ngā Mea', led by staff and senior girls.
- Our Head Boy and Head Girl will speak, supported by the waiata, 'Ma te Mahi Ka Ora'.
- At this point formalities will be over and following a short address by Principal, John Wootton, new families will be individually greeted by staff and Board of Trustees representatives (a handshake rather than a hongi in these CoVid times).
- Refreshments will be served in the hall for all new students and their whānau. At approximately 10am, students will return to their classes.
