From our Principal

We are now half way through what has been a very strange term. We can only imagine what life has been like for Aucklanders, especially the school teachers, children and parents in Tamaki Makaurau as they move inexorably to 100 days of lockdown. Level Two is a world away from what Aucklanders are experiencing, but even so, we have been negatively impacted by the Level Two restrictions that require us to keep parents out of school during the school day.

We enjoy contact with our parent community and we regret the fact that all the really enjoyable school / community activities that are part and parcel of the festive season have to be done without our parents. The bottom line is that everything we are doing, we are doing to keep our children safe and I know we have your total support in that.

Vaccination D day

It is D Day next Monday 15th for vaccinations. All frontline staff in New Zealand schools are required to have had their first vaccination in order to be able to continue working in schools. We have no work / tasks that we can deploy non-vaccinated staff to, so we are lucky that no staff have indicated that they will not have their first dose by next Monday. Most staff are, in fact already double vaxed.

Vaccination



Students who are 12 years and over are now eligible to receive Covid vaccinations. While this is not yet mandatory, if a student is vaccinated, the school is required to keep a record. All students twelve years or over who are vaccinated, should provide the school with a record of the official vaccination certificate, once you have received it. The best way to do this is to email a copy to the school office.

Once every two years New Zealand primary and intermediate schools are required to survey their parent communities on the content of the Health and P.E. curriculum.
