The Junior Sports Leagues are going to be starting up at Te Rauparaha Arena. Basketball is played on a Tuesday or Wednesday (depending on team numbers) for Year 3 & 4; starting 22/23 June and runs until 30/31 August and are played between 3:30 and 4:30pm. There will be 9 games in total.

This is a modified version of basketball where the students play 4 aside and on a smaller court. Games are 10 minutes each half with a minute for half time. There is a cost associated with this which will between \$15 and \$25 depending on how many teams and the number in each team.
