Term 1 Wk 4	Meet the Teacher	PURPOSE: An opportunity for parents to meet their child's teacher in their learning environment DETAILS: - Who: parents/caregivers & students - How: groups of 4 families in one time slot - Duration: 10 minutes	
Term 2 Wk 3	Learning Conversation & Report 1	PURPOSE: An opportunity for teachers to provide specific information around student learning and progress DETAILS: - Who: just parents/caregivers - How: one time slot for each student - Duration: 15 minutes	
Term 3 Wk 5	Learning Conversation & Report 2	 At the Learning Conversation you will be provided with a report that lists key aspects of learning in Reading, Writing and Mathematics, as well as The Adventure Way Traits. The teacher will have highlighted aspects your child has <i>achieved</i> only for content that has been covered so far this year. Teachers will refer to this during the meeting. a) Key Aspects of Learning This will be based on the curriculum level(s) your child is currently working within. Your child may be working at different curriculum levels for Mathematics, Reading and Writing. 	
	(a follow-up from Term 2)	 b) The Adventure Way The Adventure Way overview will be based on your child's year level. The teacher will share 2-3 aspects that have been a key focus for your child. You will have the opportunity to talk about Adventure Way traits that you would most like your child to develop this year. A copy of The Adventure Way traits will be shared with you prior to the Learning Conversations to allow you time to familiarise yourself with the aspects. 	
Term 4 Wk 10	Written Report	PURPOSE: To provide a summary of progress and achievement across the year. DETAILS: The report will cover: ➡ All curriculum areas The Adventure Way traits ➡ Student Reflection (Yrs 3-8)
