Next term Rimu Syndicate is focusing on health and wellbeing as our inquiry. As part of this we want to take the students to Titahi Bay Beach to learn about water safety and life saving. Your child would be participating on either Wednesday 16 or 23 November. There will be 3 parts to the day.

- Theory
- Beach Activities
- Water Activities

We will be bussing to and from the beach.

Before we confirm this trip, we need to know if you would be happy to support it. We will be using some KiwiSport money to offset the cost, however a donation of \$15 per student is needed. We will also need a ratio of 1 adult to 5 students, meaning we need plenty of help. As a helper you will be expected to take part in all of the activities, including entering the water up to the waist to ensure safety. Surf Lifesaving NZ has stated that full vaccination of all adults is required. If we do not get enough support then we will not be able to go ahead with this amazing opportunity.
