All students need to have dinner prior to arriving at school - they will receive a light supper at the zoo. Students will have a continental breakfast in the morning and they will receive Hot Chips when they return to school. Each child needs a packed lunch box and water bottle.

6:00pm: Meet at School - load buses

6:15pm: Leave School and travel into Wellington Zoo

7:00pm: Met at the Main entrance by Night Ranger and settle into accommodation

7:30pm: Night Tour - awesome activities and a look behind the scenes

Students will get out and about in the Zoo, see what happens behind the scenes and tempt one of the amazing animals with a night-time snack. Students will then have a light supper (biscuits and hot drinks) after the tour and will spend the night with their buddies either in the Archibald Centre, which overlooks Monkey Island, or snoozing in the Living Room, in close quarters with some of the cutest critters.

The next morning will start with a continental breakfast and another tour with a ranger, who will take us bright and early for a walk through the Zoo. Students will get to see what happens at the Zoo before visitors arrive and they will make a special gift to keep the animals stimulated and happy. Our adventure will end when the Zoo opens at 9.30am.
