Beach Safety

The beach safety programme is run out of Titahi Bay Surf Lifesaving Club. It involves a full day of supervised activities and education within the club rooms, on the beach and in the water. We will be busing to and from the venue on the following days:

Monday 21 November - Rooms 24 and 25
Tuesday 22 November - Rooms 26 and 27

We do require 9 or 10 parents to assist with the practical (beach and water) part of the day, so as to ensure we have a safe and suitable ratio of adults to students. Supervision does require adults to get in the water.

ASB Sports Arena

Our Sports Day will take place on Wednesday the 23rd of November and will involve all students busing to the ASB Sports Arena in Kilbirnie where they will take place in the following - Speedball, Pickleball, Korfbal and Floorball.

There is no need for extra adult supervision as the programme is run by trained instructors. Although you are welcome to drop by and observe your child participating, if you are in the neighbourhood.

The cost of both programmes has been significantly subsidised, but there is still a shortfall to be covered. A donation of \$22 per student would be greatly appreciated.
