The Nīkau Team are excited for the new year and to be working with your children. The Nīkau team comprises of; Richard McQueen (R19), Amy Churchill (R5), Alesha Wilson (R4) Skye Kim (R3) and myself (R2). Tania Bourke is also part of our teaching team; teaching in Room 2 most Thursdays and she will cover most of the CRT release in other Nīkau classrooms.
