WELCOME BACK TO TERM 2

Teachers will continue to run structured literacy and numeracy programmes for the first three sessions of the day. Our writing programme will have more of a non-fiction focus as students look at research and report style writing. In mathematics, classes will delve into multiplication and division, geometry, statistics and algebra.

INQUIRY

This term our Inquiry is Thrive versus Survive. During this Inquiry, students will explore how animals adapt, rely on each other, and bounce back from challenges to thrive in their environments. We will weave our art programme into this, using sketching and collage as our main mediums.

PHYSCIAL EDUCATION

Term 2 means Cross Country. This is an opportunity for our students to showcase their physical fitness and endurance. We may also complete this unit with a fun colour run.
