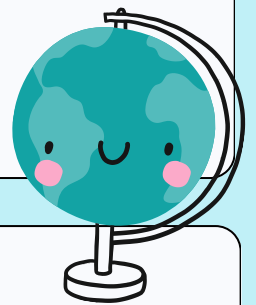
Weekly Home Learning

The purpose of home learning in Kōwhai is to provide children with extra opportunities to practise and reinforce the learning taking place at school.

Each week, a named folder will come home containing practice activities for mathematics and/or literacy. Week to week, your child's home learning journey may vary depending on their progress; some things will be more challenging, and require repeated practice, where as some things will be less challenging and will require less practice.

We recommend you to sit with your child when they complete tasks, but if they feel confident to be independent, please encourage this.

Home learning is optional and while it won't be formally assessed by a teacher, it can be a great way to support your child's learning.



Returning Home Learning Pocket

All paper activities do not need to be returned to school. Books and laminated items can be returned when your child has finished with them.

Please return your child's Home Learning Pocket to school every Friday (or before) so that teachers can provide new learning for the following week.
